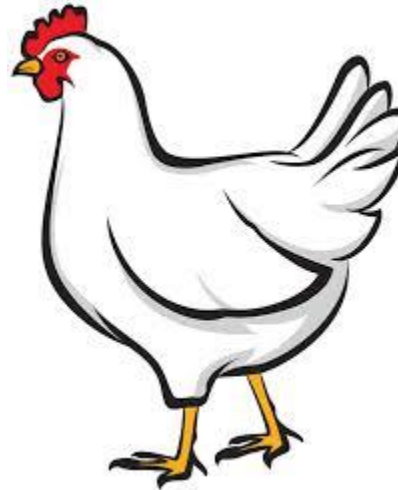
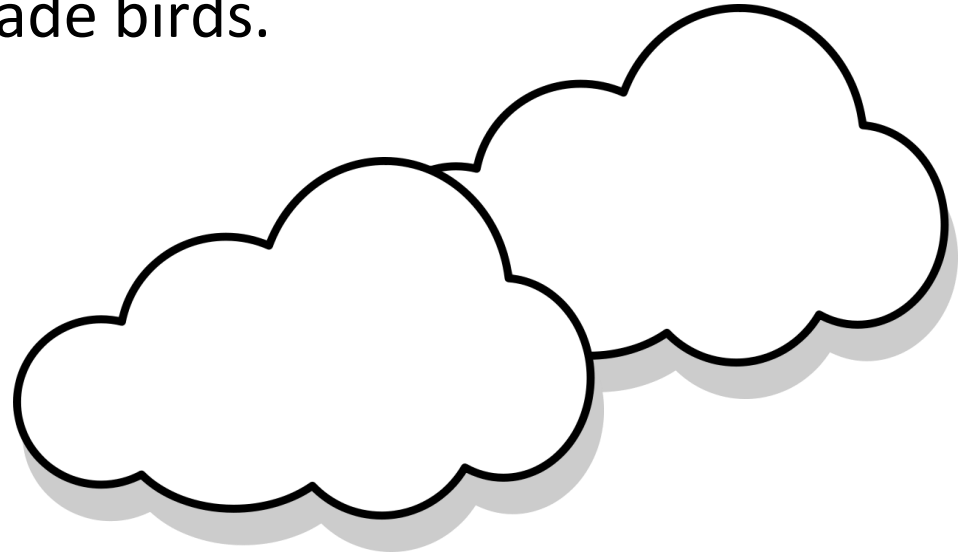
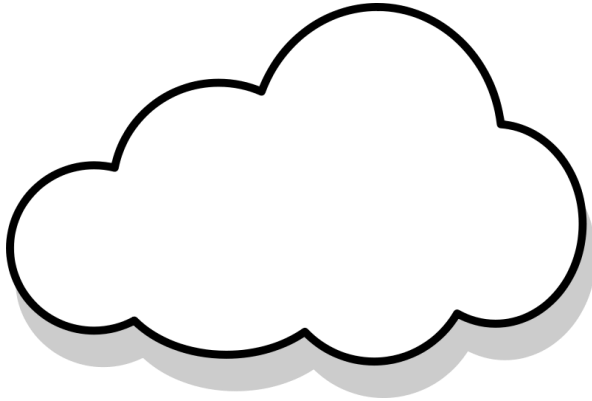

5th Day of Creation

On the 5th day of Creation, God created fowl and sea creatures. I have used these for a young preschooler class at church. If possible, let the students feel feathers and see pictures of different types of birds. Students can color the birds while you talk about the sound an owl makes. Take this time to discuss the sound a chicken makes and what hens lay (eggs). Eagles are birds of prey and a sign of strength. Eagles wings are mentioned in the Bible in Isaiah 30:41. Most birds have a certain song or sound they make.

You may want to print the "God made fish" sheet onto the back of the first sheet. I usually give my students or kids a blue crayon and fish stickers to use with their ocean scene. They are encouraged to decorate their ocean scene with all kinds of sea creatures.
