## Day 1 of Creation Activity Sheet

You can choose to use these activity sheets two ways. First, you could just use the 1<sup>st</sup> sheet as a coloring sheet and keep it simple. The other option is to print both sheets out. Encourage your student to color the 2<sup>nd</sup> sheet with the Day side yellow and the Night side black to represent the separation of light and darkness. Next, your student will color the Earth and cut it out. Have your student paste the Earth in the center of the 2<sup>nd</sup> sheet. You can choose to cut out the verse to glue it in the middle of the Earth or even on the back. Enjoy!
