## Jesus Washes Disciples' Feet

This activity sheet is an easy hands-on activity. After reading the account of Jesus washing his disciples' feet, take this time to talk more in depth about what his example means for us. Explain to them that just as the disciples' feet were dirty, so are our hearts with sin. We need Jesus to clean us from our sin just as he washed his disciples' feet clean.
