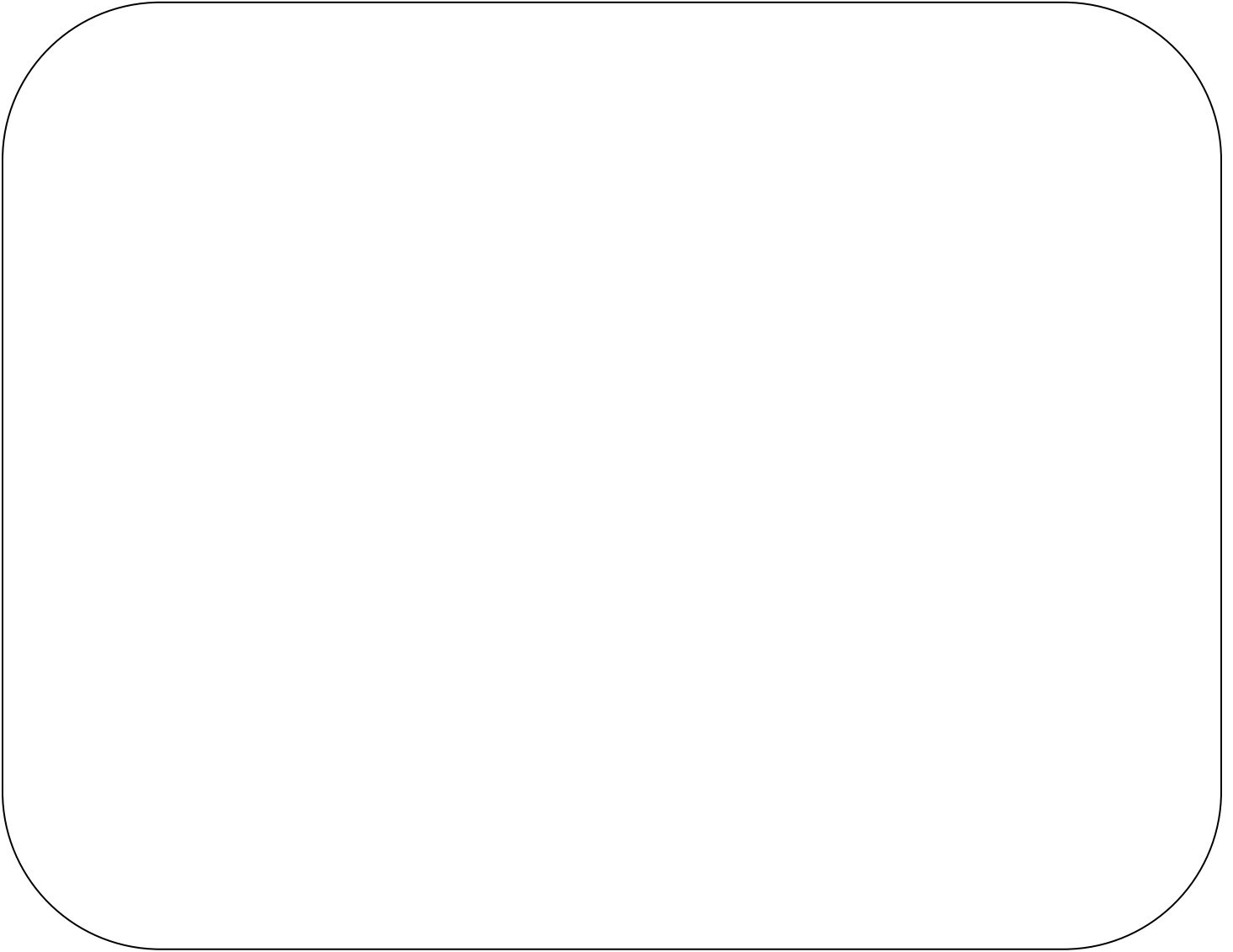

*Ephesians 6:1*



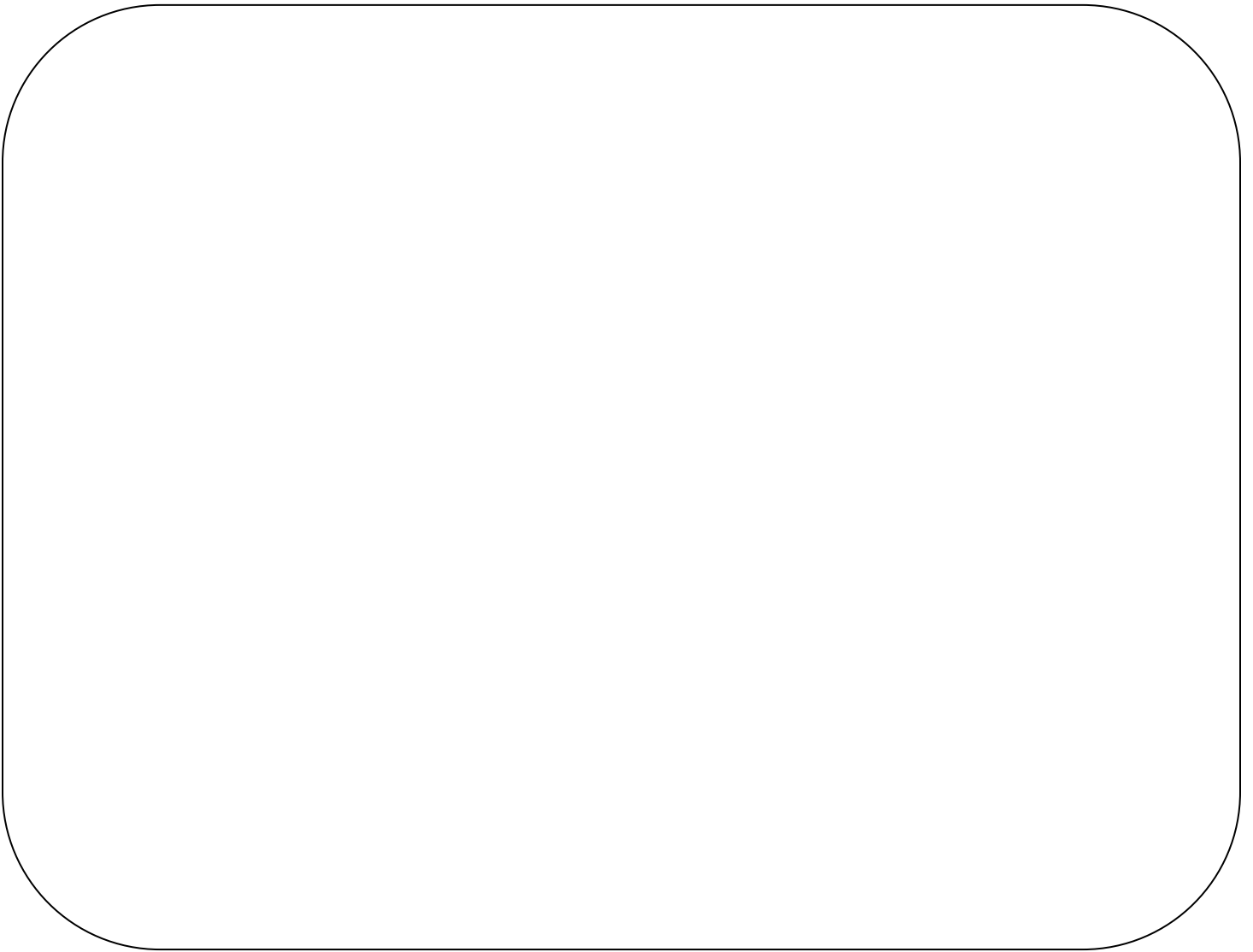
Draw a picture illustrating how you could show obedience to your parents. Write a sentence or two about your picture.

*Enter into his gates with Thanksgiving and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. Psalm 100:4*



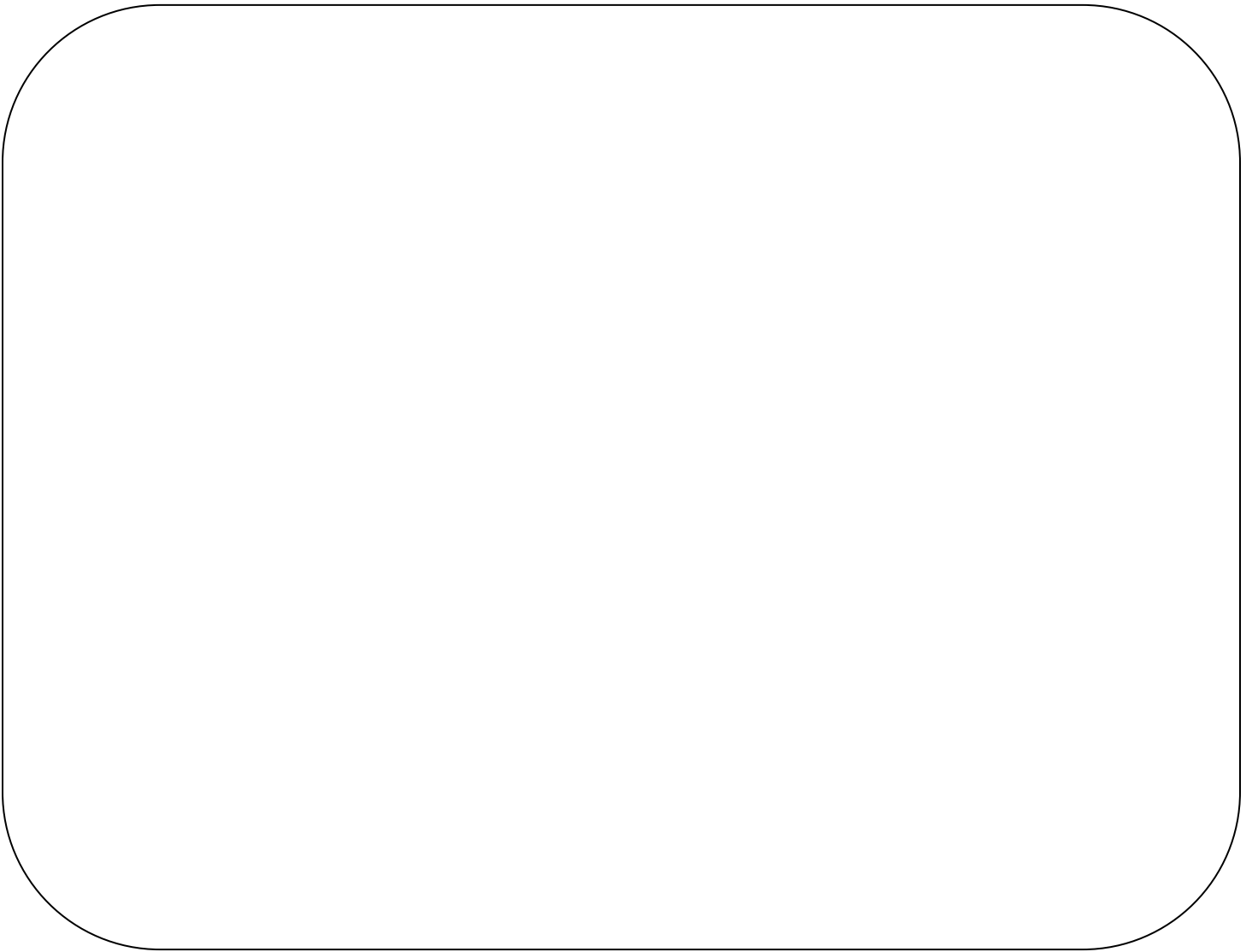
Draw a picture of something or someone that you are thankful to God for. Write a sentence or two about your picture.

Draw a picture of something that seems impossible. It could be a miracle from the Bible or something silly like a boy lifting a car! Write a sentence or two about your picture.

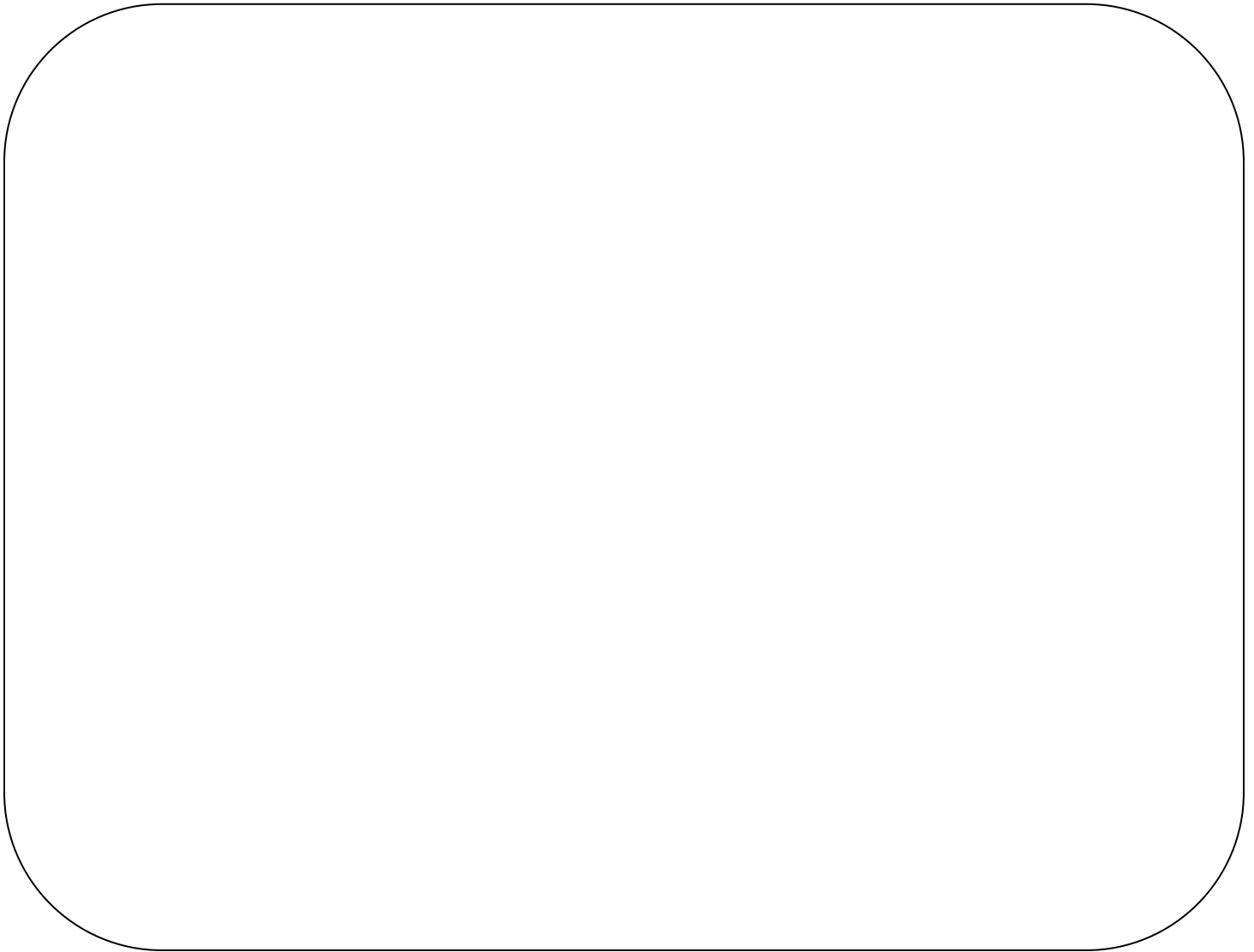

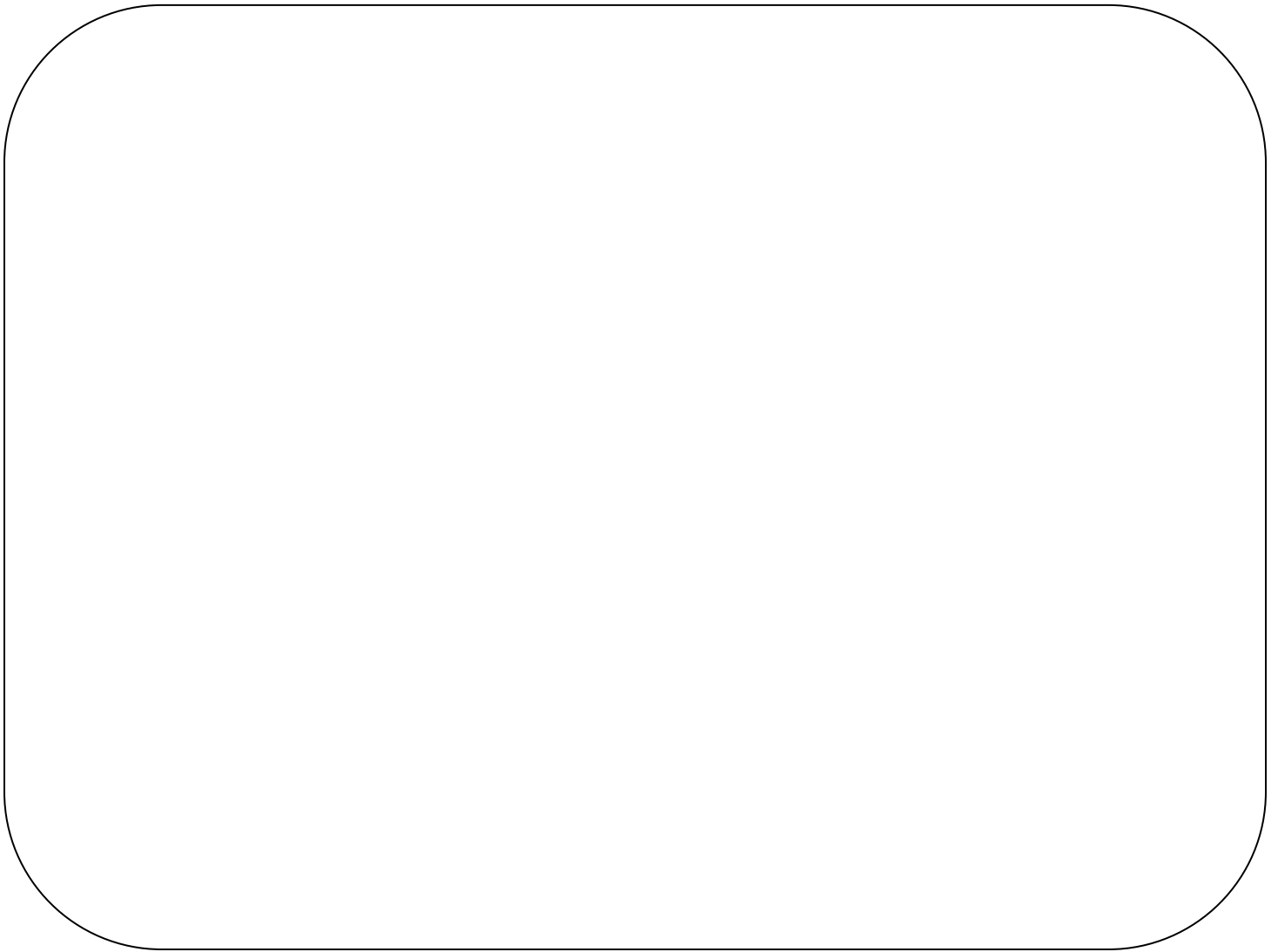
Draw a picture of something your family does that pleases God. Write a sentence or two about your picture.

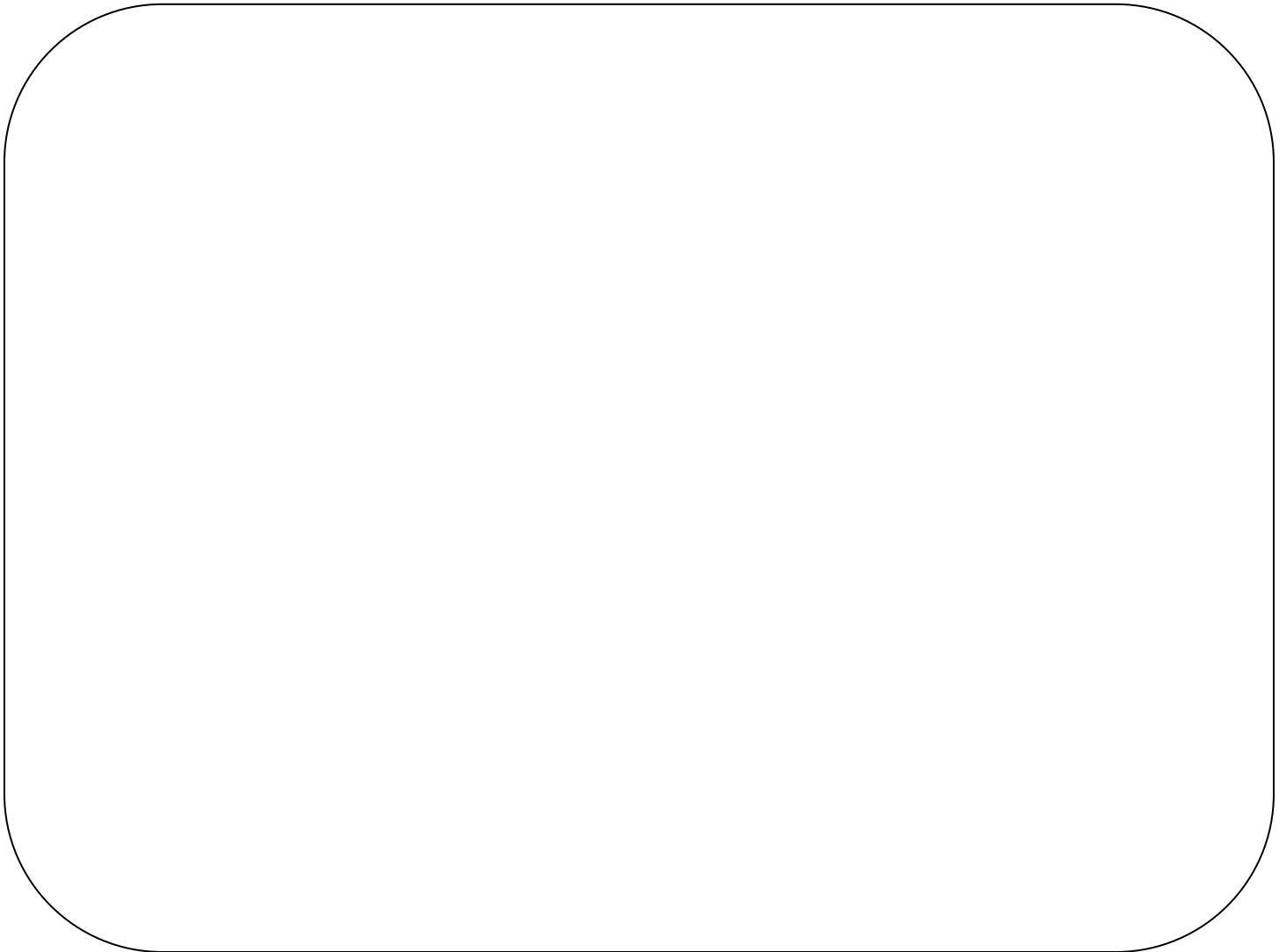

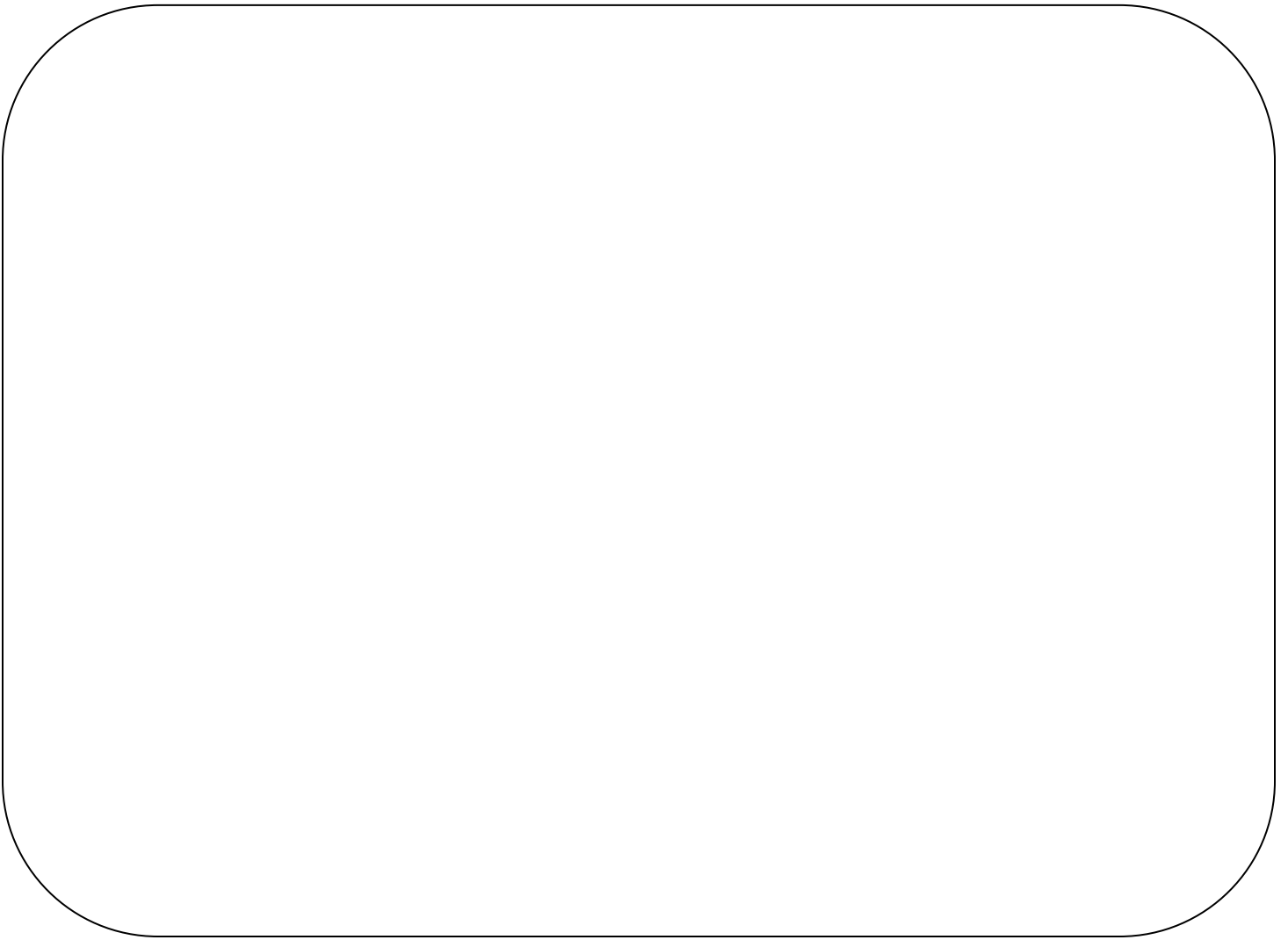

When we read our Bible or hear the word of God read to us, it grows our faith in God.

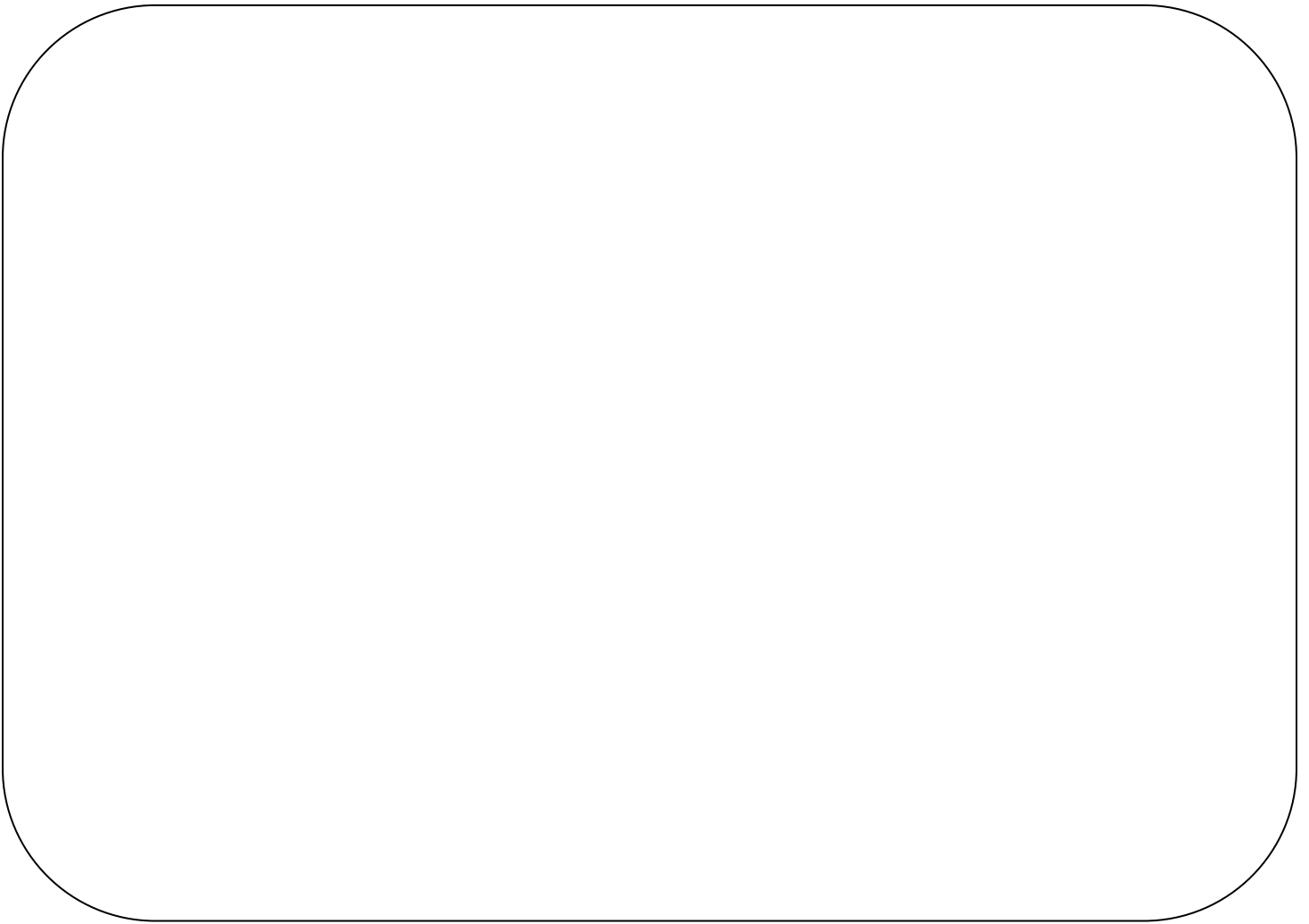
Draw a picture illustrating what the memory verse means to you. Write a sentence or two about your picture.

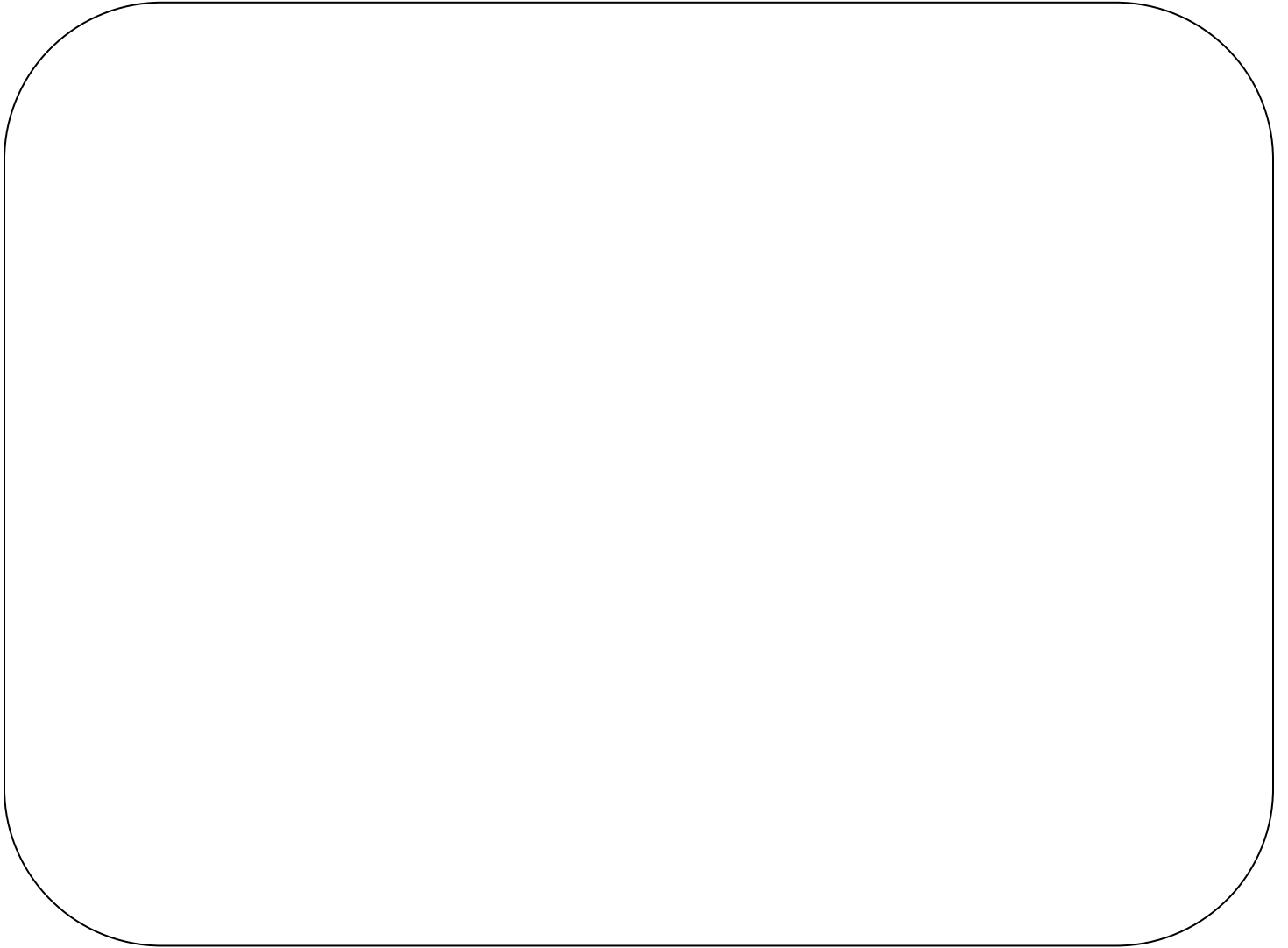

Draw a picture of something that makes you want to jump up and down with happiness and joy. Write a sentence or two about your picture.

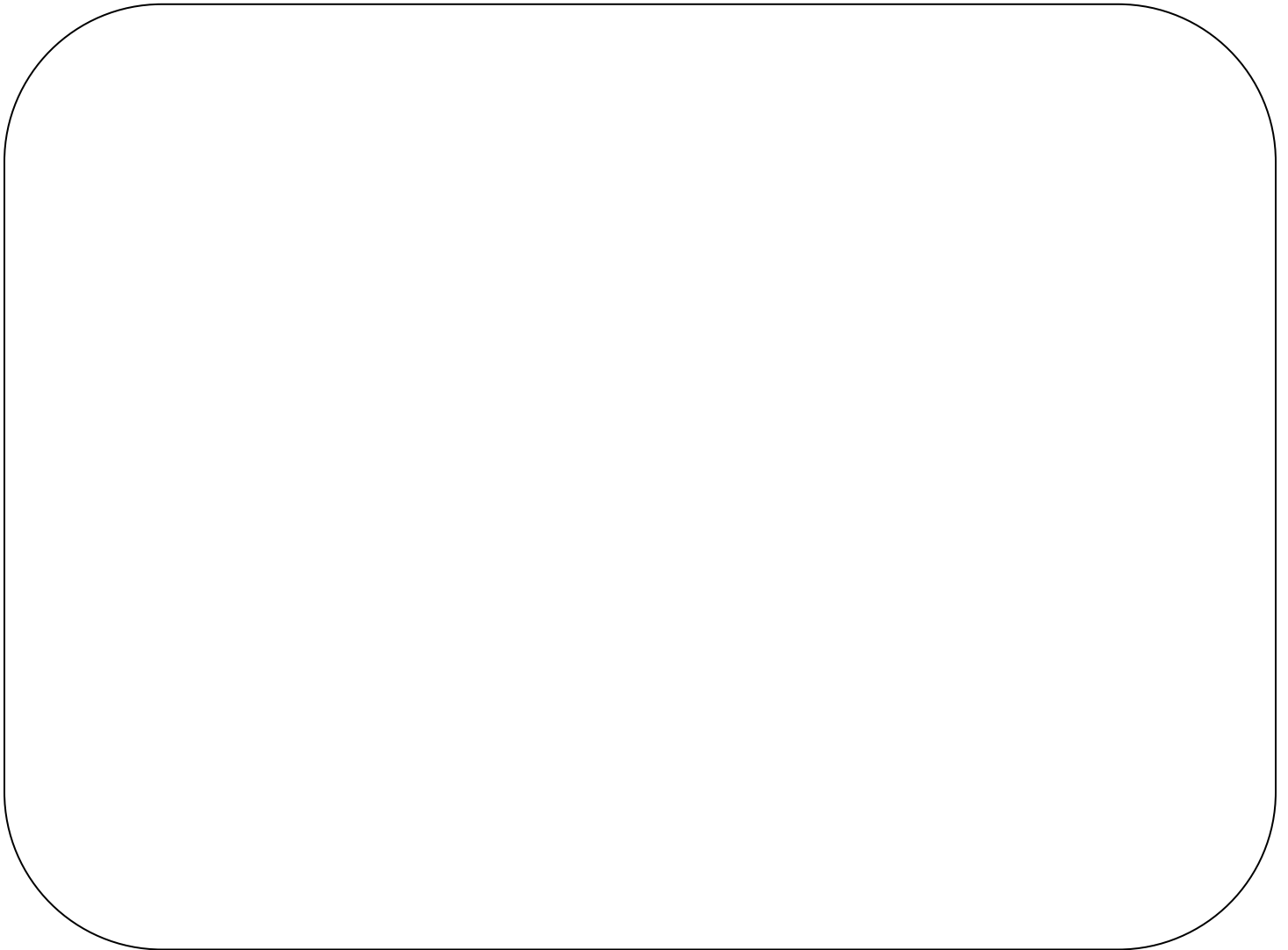

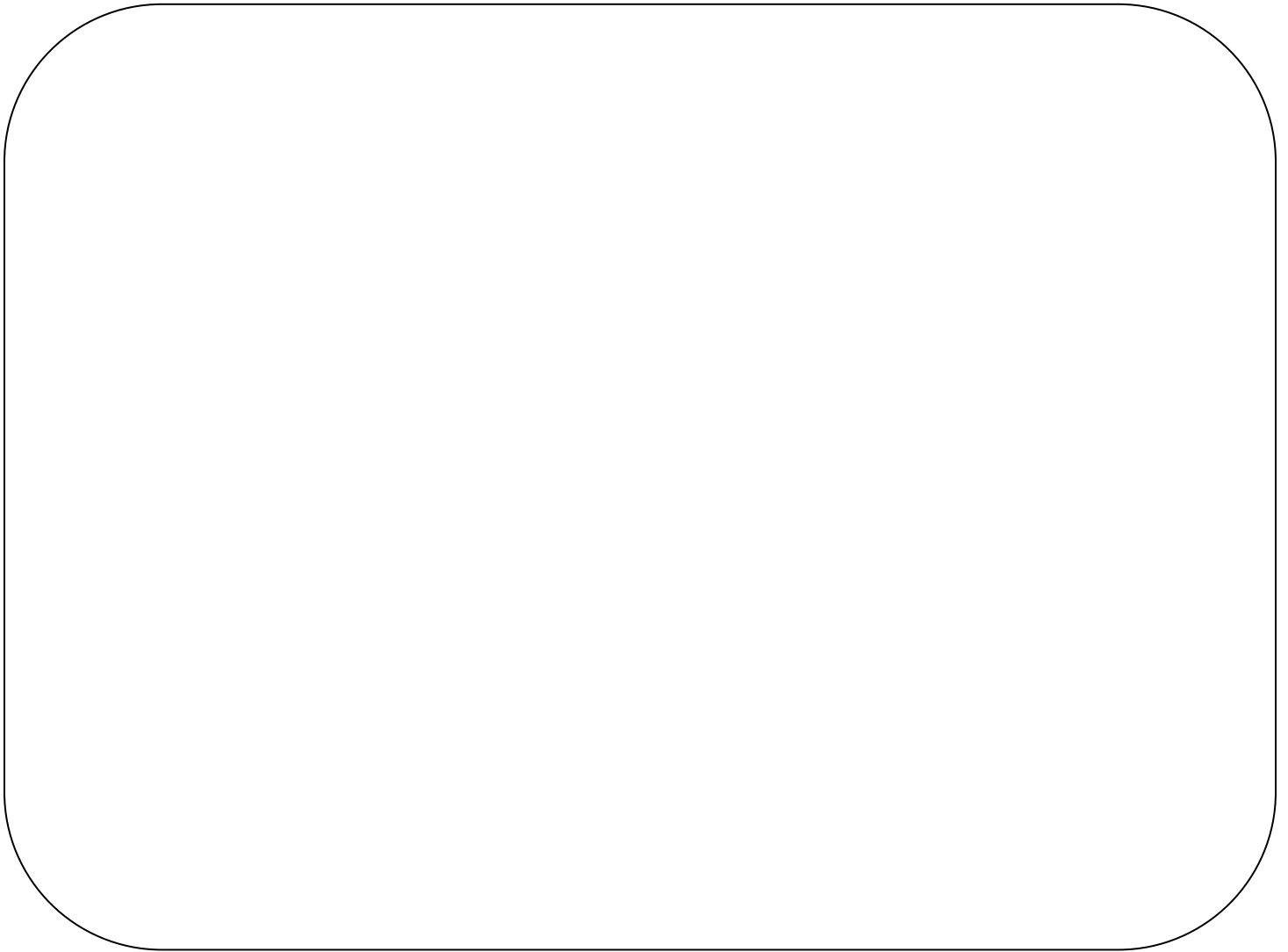

*Romans 3:23*



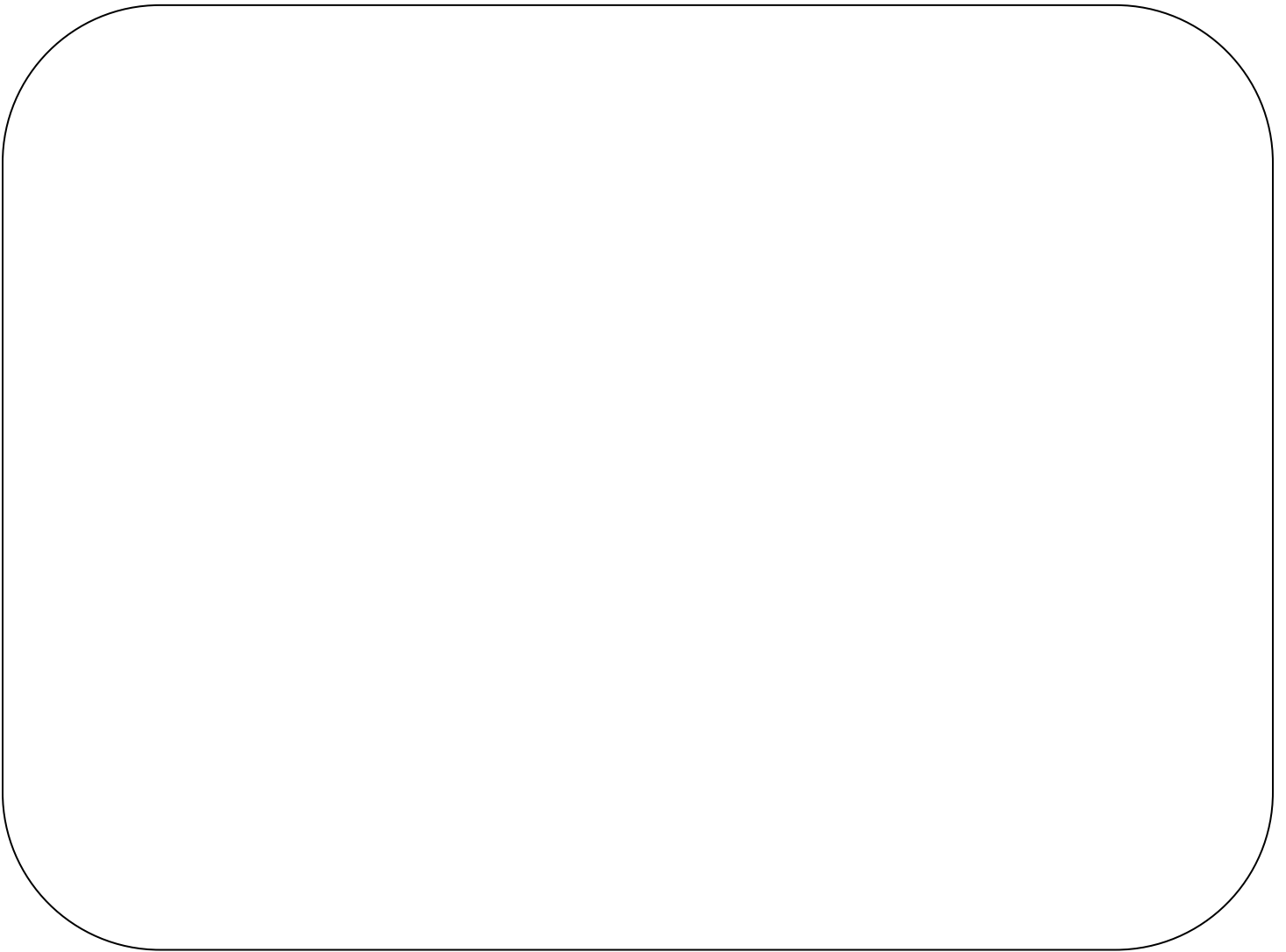
We all sin. None of us deserve what God gives us. Draw a picture of a time when you sinned. Write a sentence or two about your picture.

*And be ye kind, one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.* *Ephesians 4:32*



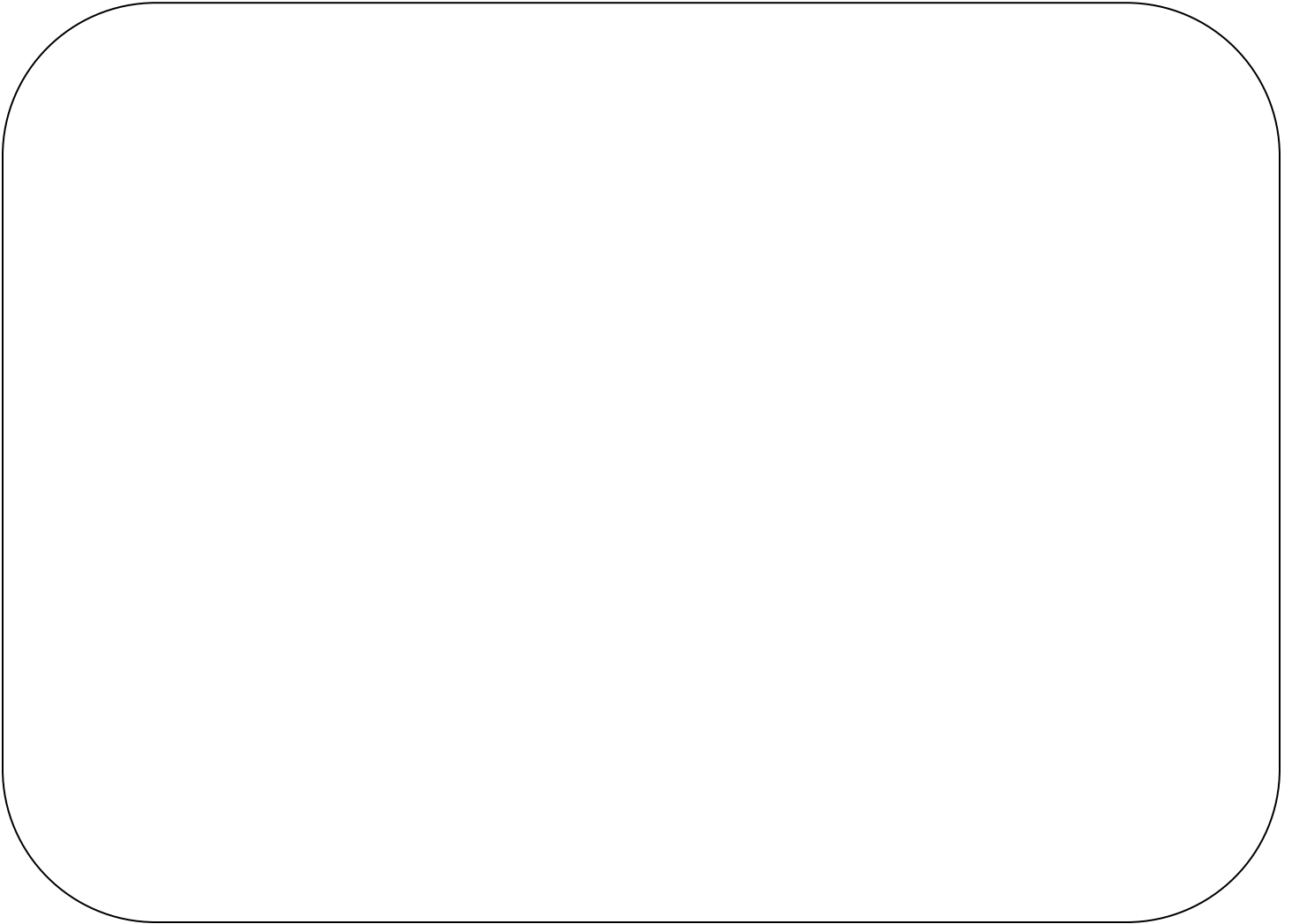
God wants us to be kind to one another. Draw a picture of someone doing something kind for another person. Write a sentence or two about your picture.

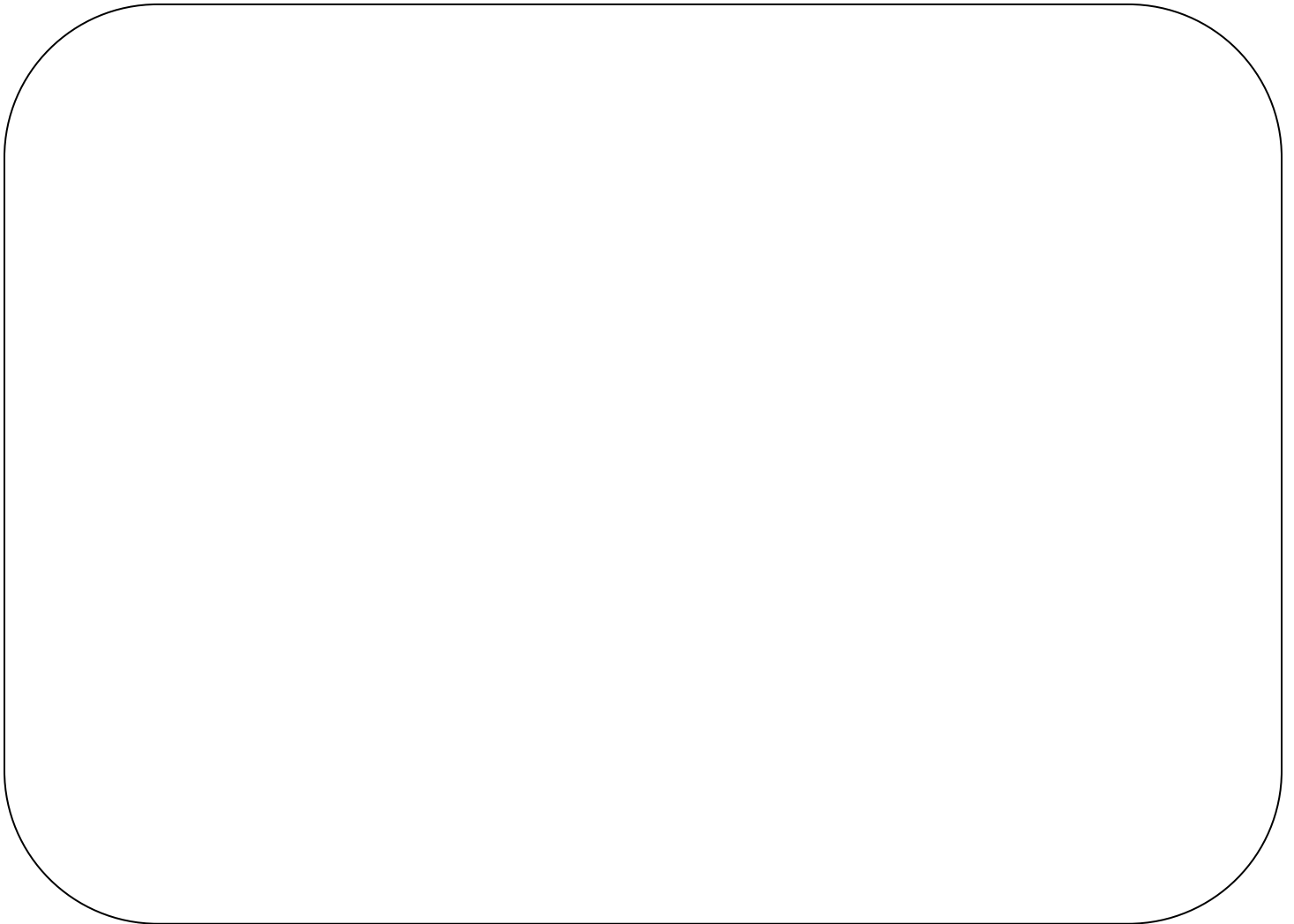

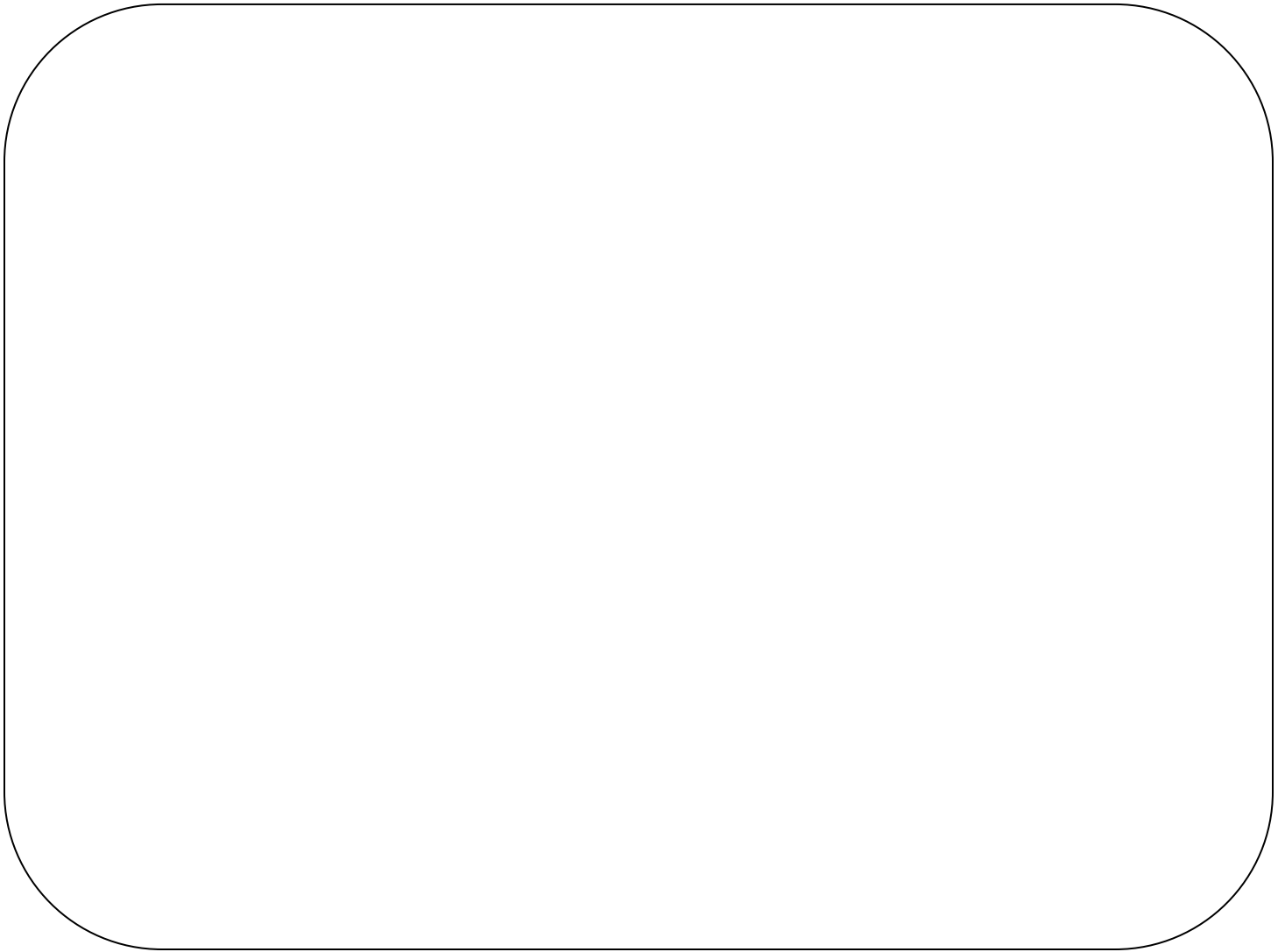

*Hebrews 13:8*



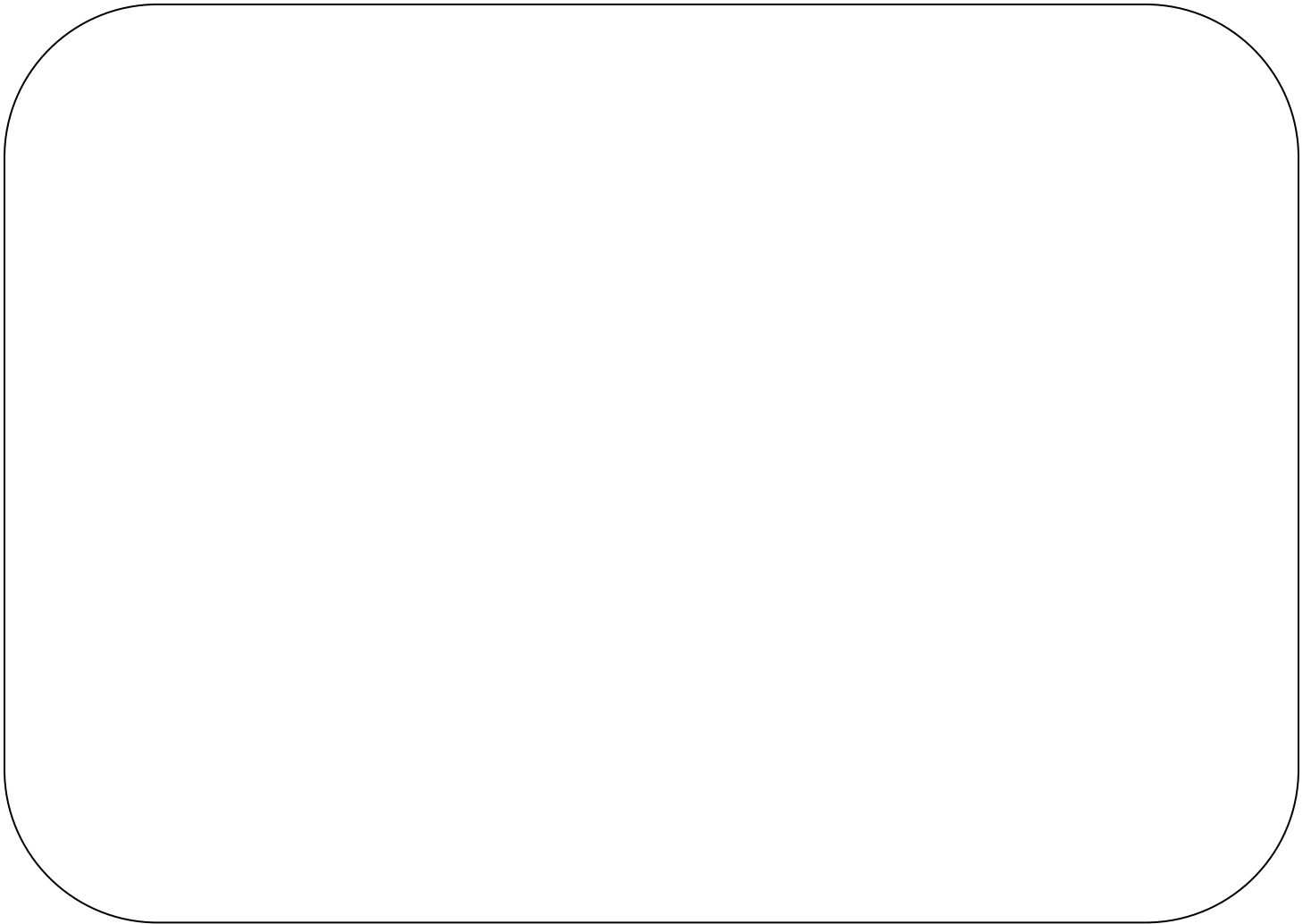

God wants us to give thanks in everything. Draw a picture of someone or something you are thankful for. Write a sentence or two about your picture.

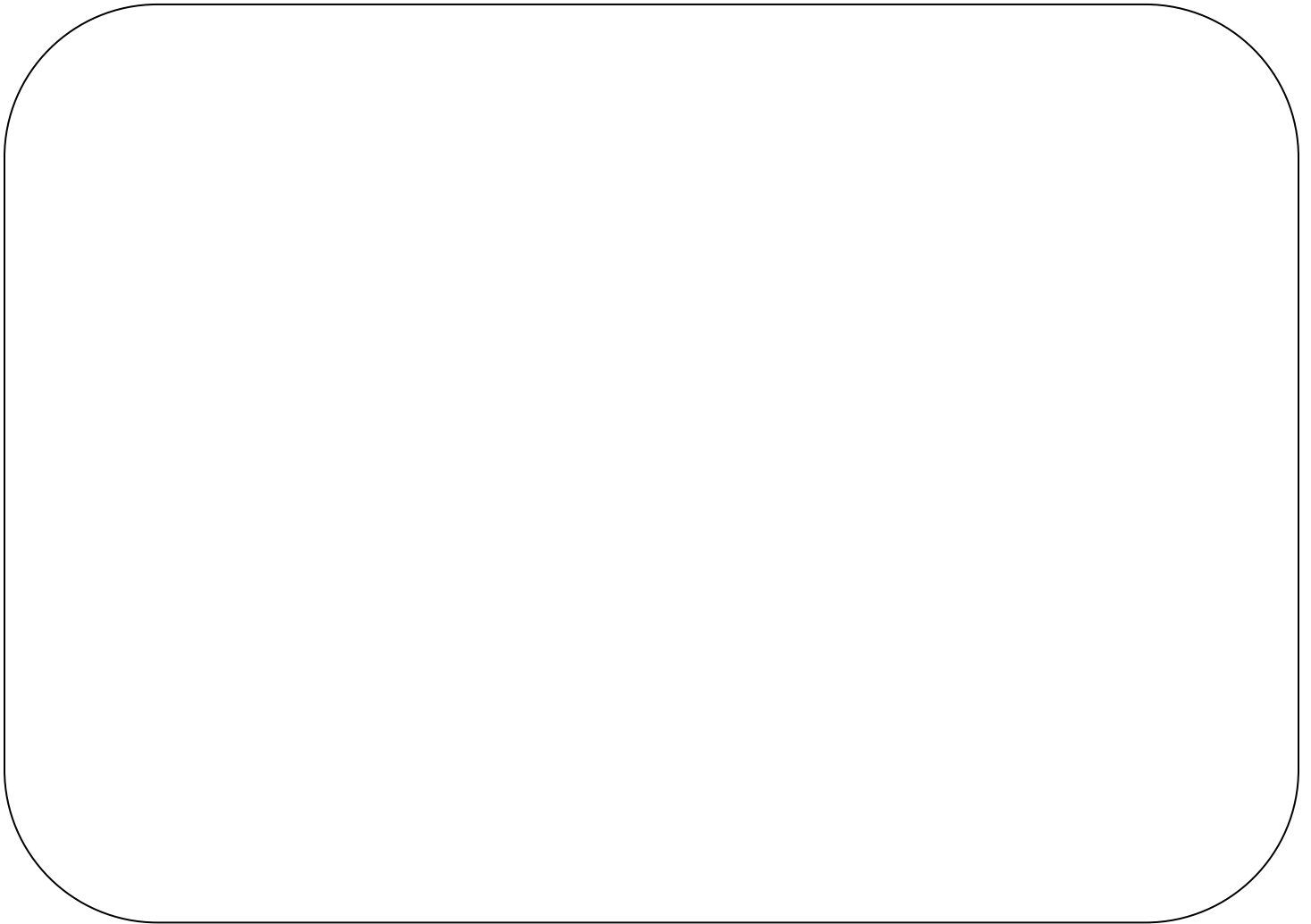

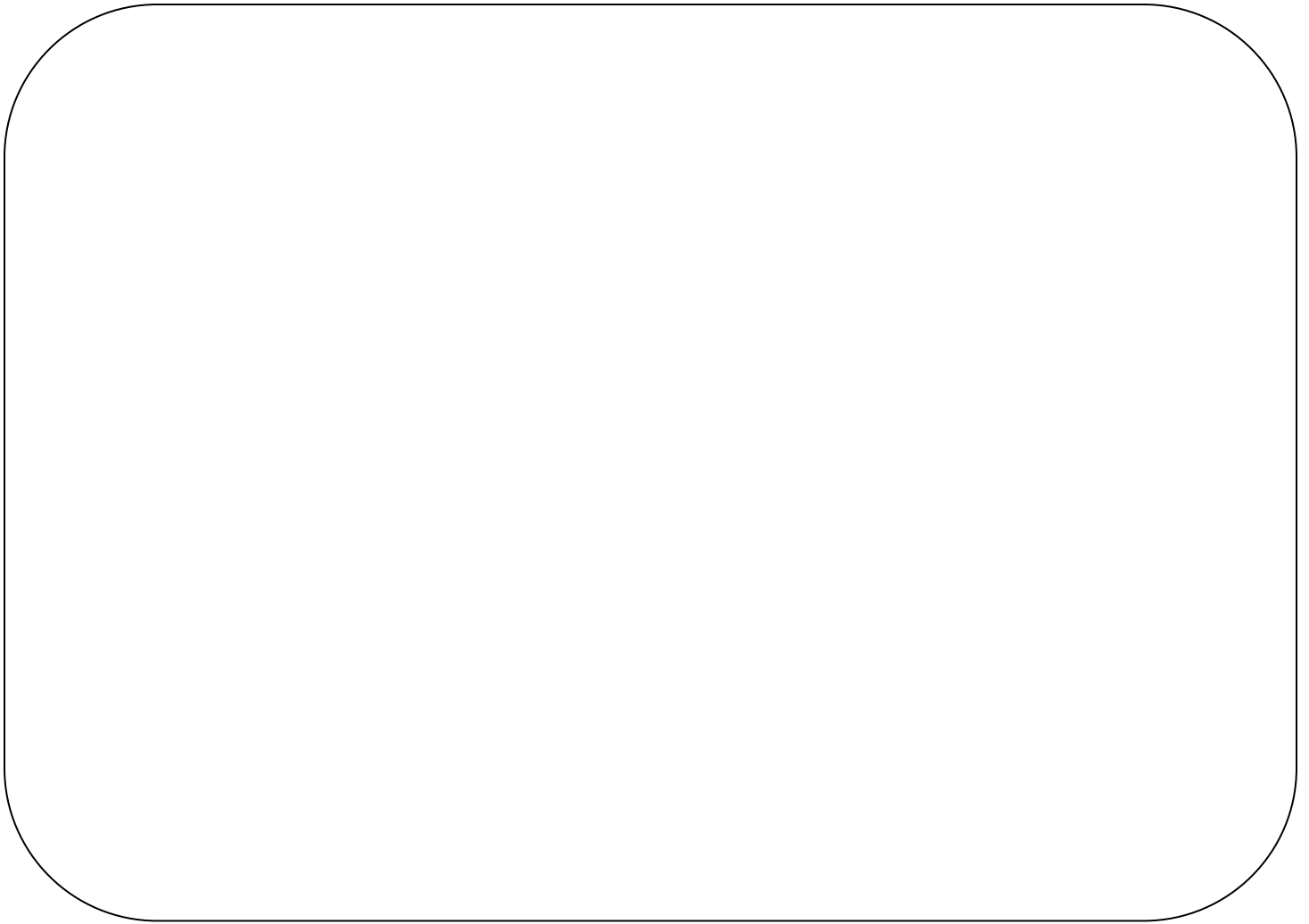
