Thankful Wreath

All you need for the Thankful Wreath is this printout, paper plates, glue, string, and construction paper. Cut out the scripture verse to glue to the center of your plate. Next, cut leaves out of construction paper to adorn your wreath. You can use the leaf templates supplied on page 2. If you would like, use real leaves, preferably colored fall leaves, to glue around your wreath instead. Poke a hole in the top to string it. Voila! You are done! One way to extend this craft is to ask students to write something they are thankful for on each leaf. Happy Thanksgiving!
