

A feeling of sympathy for and a desire to help someone who is suffering




Draw a picture illustrating how you could show compassion to someone you know.

PEACEMAKER


One who promotes harmony in personal relationships

JOYFUL


Happiness and delight in your heart that comes only from Jesus

SELF-CONTROL


Control of your feelings and behavior

Maybe you aren't that great at math, or you would love to play the piano. Draw something that you hope to persevere in and then write about it.

HUMBLE

Not proud or boastful; not thinking more of yourself than others



When you are humble, you don't draw attention to yourself. Humble people do not brag about their possessions or accomplishments. Draw a picture how you can show humility. Write 1-2 sentences explaining your picture.

COURAGEOUS

Mental or moral strength to persevere and withstand danger, fear, or difficulty; brave



We all get scared or frightened at times. In those moments, remember that God is with you even if you can't see Him. Draw a picture of yourself or someone who had courage even though they might have been scared. Write 1-2 sentences about your picture.

ORDERLY


Arranged or disposed in some order or pattern; governed by law, well-behaved

Mindful, observant; sensitive to the needs of others; to take notice



KINDNESS


Going out of your way to be friendly, helpful, or considerate

Having or showing a quiet and gentle nature; not wanting to argue with other people




Some people are naturally gentler and quieter natured. These people seem to be better listeners and do not draw attention to themselves. A meek person is not argumentative.

Able to be trusted to do what is right or do the things that are expected or required




God has blessed each of with talents and abilities. We have a responsibility to use what

HONEST


Not hiding the truth about someone or something; being genuine and straightforward

PATIENCE


Bearing pains or trials calmly without complaint

THANKFUL


Expressive of thanks; well pleased; grateful for what you have

Being happy to use your time and money to help others




God says in His word that when we give, we should give with a cheerful heart. Can you think of a time when you gave of your time, belongings, or money to someone else?

RIGHTEOUS


Morally upright and justifiable; with no guilt or sin

ENCOURAGING


Give support, confidence, or hope to someone

LOVING


Having affection or warm regard for another person; tender

CONTENT


Feeling or showing satisfaction with your own possessions, status, or situation

FORGIVING


To excuse a fault or an offense, pardon. To renounce anger or resentment against

FAITHFUL


True to your word and promises; reliable, dependable, and loyal
