Jesus in everything you do




Philippians 4:6

comes only from Jesus



Control of your feelings and behavior



Arranged or disposed in some order or pattern; governed by law, well behaved



Bearing pains or trials calmly or without complaint




James 1:1-3

Having affection or warm regard for another person; tender.




John 15:12

To excuse a fault or an offense; pardon. To renounce anger or resentment against




Colossians 3:13
