Character Trait	Definition	Scripture
Compassion	A feeling of sympathy for and a desire to help someone who is suffering	Ephesians 4:32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.
Teachable	Capable of being taught; apt and willing to learn	2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.
Prayerful	Inclined to pray frequently; remembering Jesus in everything you do	Philippians 4:6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.
Obedient	Doing what is asked of you promptly; willing to obey; following God's commandments	Ephesians 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.
Peacemaker	One who promotes harmony in personal relationships	Proverbs 15:1 A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.

Joyful	Happiness and delight in your heart that comes only from Jesus	Psalm 100:1 Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all ye lands.

Humble	Not proud or boastful; not thinking more of yourself than others	Philippians 2:3 Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.
Courageous	Mental or moral strength to persevere and withstand danger, fear, or difficulty; brave	Psalm 31:24 Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.
Orderly	Arranged or disposed in some order or pattern; governed by law, well behaved	1 Corinthians 14:40 Let all things be done decently and in order.
Attentive	Mindful, observant; sensitive to the needs of others; to take notice	Psalm 85:8 I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for he will speak peace unto his people, and to his saints: but let them not turn again to folly.

Kindness	Going out of your way to be friendly, helpful, and considerate	Luke 6:31 And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise.
Meek	Having or showing a quiet and gentle nature- not wanting to argue with other people	Matthew 5:5 Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.
Responsible	Able to be trusted to do what is right or to do the things that are expected or required	Galatians 6:5 For every man shall bear his own burden.
Honest	Not hiding the truth about someone or something- being genuine and straightforward	Proverbs 12:22 Lying lips are abomination to the LORD: but they that deal truly are his delight.
Patience	Bearing pains or trials calmly or without complaint	James 1:1-3 My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience.
Thankful	Expressive of thanks; well pleased; grateful for what you have	Psalms 136:1 O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Generous	Being happy to use your time and money to help others	2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
Righteous	Morally upright and justifiable; with no guilt or sin	Psalms 5:8 Lead me, O Lord, in thy righteousness because of mine enemies; make thy way straight before my face.
Encouraging	Give support, confidence, or hope to someone	Ephesians 4:29 Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.
