

FOR THE TEACHER...

These Scripture Verse Puzzlers can be used a few different ways. For starters, if you are working with a preschooler, you can encourage them to find all the vowels within a verse by circling the vowel or dotting them with a dot marker. My favorite way to use the puzzlers is to cut the verse into strips and then give them to your student mixed up. Your student or small group will put the strips into the correct order. I usually encourage kids to glue it in order on a sheet of construction paper. To increase difficulty, rather than cut the verse into strips, cut the verse into individual words. That way, students must use the scripture verse cards to put it in the right order. They can be encouraged to paste it in the correct order onto a sheet of construction paper. This is an effective activity for homeschool families and Sunday School classes.

Once done, review the verse with them.
