How we use these Reading Logs

Reading logs are an excellent tool to use if you are trying to instill a love for reading in your kids. I have used a variety of reading logs over the years. When my kids are younger, I use a reading log that counts the number of books we read together during story time. You may want to start with a 25-book reading log or go all the way to 100. We use stickers to fill in the blanks. So, if we read 4 books then my preschooler puts 4 stickers on the log. Another option is to use stamps or initial it. As my kids get older, we advance to a reading log that has 5-20 spots out of the 100 that are tinted in gray to represent the books they are required to read to me. Eventually each child advances to a reading log that requires them to write the name of the book they read during reading time or finished completely. Some books will allot them with more than one point. Once they finish their reading log, there is some sort of prize... maybe a trip to get ice cream... a date with dad... etc.
