Our Famous Black Americans Draw & Write sheets are a perfect avenue for those of you wanting to marry writing and history. Pair these writing sheets with an educational video and history reader, and you have an elementary social studies lesson ready to go.

In the **draw section**, encourage your student to draw something that represents what the historical figure is known for.

In the **writing section**, ask your student to write about their picture explaining what it is the historical figure did. This is a great time to reiterate what the famous figure was known for.
